Guidelines for collecting feedback from students and alumni of the Estonian Academy of Music and Theatre

- 1. The Academy regularly solicits feedback from students and alumni to
 - evaluate the adequacy of the content and quality of offered education in terms of student expectations;
 - evaluate the quality of the organisation and infrastructure of studies and the general reputation of the Academy in society;
 - collect proposals on improvement of particular subject courses, study arrangements and the learning environment;
 - evaluate the competitiveness and success of the graduates of the Academy in the labour market.
- 2. The feedback surveys for students and alumni are conducted by the Registry and Student Affairs Department.
- 3. Students are surveyed in three ways:
 - Continuous monitoring of the quality of teaching in subject courses the survey is conducted online in the studies information system immediately after a subject course to provide the teaching staff member feedback on the content, methodology and organisation of the subject course; the results are analysed by the relevant teaching staff member who provides feedback to students and records areas of improvement in his or her evaluation documents;
 - Feedback from new students the survey is conducted on a paper questionnaire in the context of the subject ÜAX400, *University Studies and Professional World*, to collect feedback on admission procedures, entrance examinations and the organisation of studies in the first weeks; the results of the survey are used by the Registry and Student Affairs Department to make improvements in the admission system and in the advisory services provided to students;
 - Feedback from graduates on the organisation of studies and the quality of the learning environment the survey is conducted online in the studies information system among the graduates from bachelor's and master's degree programmes; the results of the survey are analysed by the Student Council and the Study Committee, and the conclusions are published in the yearbook of the Academy.
- 4. Students are surveyed on the basis of the questionnaires provided in these Guidelines. The surveys are anonymous.
- 5. An alumni survey is conducted at the end of each calendar year. All graduates of that year are interviewed by e-mail or telephone to ascertain whether they
 - continue their studies in the same or a different specialty,
 - are employed in their field of specialisation,
 - are employed in another field,
 - are looking for work,
 - are on parental leave or homemakers.

The results of the annual alumni survey are published in the yearbook of the Academy.
