



Call for Erasmus+ Trainee within the area of Distance Learning

The Norwegian Academy of Music is looking for an Erasmus+ trainee to manage and help develop the Academy's use of LoLa, a low latency AV streaming system used for distance learning.

About the Academy

The Norwegian Academy of Music (NMH) is a leading artistic and academic university college. The Academy is an internationally renowned institution offering music education of the highest calibre. The Norwegian Academy of Music educates performers, composers, conductors, music educators, and music therapists at undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate levels. The Academy hosts almost 400 concerts annually and is at the forefront of artistic development work and research in music. About the traineeship

We are looking to develop and increase our distance learning activity in order to fully take advantage of the possibilities within the LoLa system.

The primary task for the trainee will be to:

- set up, test and to be present in order to assist staff and students during NMH's LoLa sessions.

Other tasks within the area of audio/video for productions, filming and editing or other related tasks can also be added based on the competence and interests of the selected applicant.

We can offer access to practice rooms at the Academy, access to group lessons (upon availability), and a training/job shadowing part designed based on the trainee's interests and our staff's availability.

The traineeship is available for a period of 4-9 months starting from **1 September 2021**

About you

- You are a recent graduate or a current student in the field of sound engineering or related disciplines.
- You are a recent graduate or current student at a higher education institution taking part in the Erasmus+ programme.
- You can communicate well in English.
- You are service minded and friendly towards others.
- You have initiative and can work well unsupervised.
- Previous experience with distance learning systems will be an advantage.
- Previous experience with IT-/network-related tasks or an interest to learn more about this will be an advantage.

Practicalities

- Your home institution will approve the traineeship and provide you with an Erasmus+ grant decided by your local national agency.
- NMH will pay an additional 3000 NOK per month.
- Accident and liability insurance is a requirement and is not provided by the Academy.
- You will have access to resources available for international students at NMH.

Application

The application letter should contain information about:

- Your skills and experience relevant to running LoLa or other distance learning programmes.
- Your skills and areas of interest in terms of job-shadowing and additional tasks you could take on within this traineeship.
- Motivation and presentation of yourself.
- Length of period you would like to apply for (minimum 4 months, maximum 9 months).

Required attachments:

- CV
- A nomination letter from your home institution confirming your student status for the time of the traineeship (current student or recent graduate), with a confirmation that you will be granted an Erasmus+ grant should you be chosen for this traineeship.

Other attachments:

- A letter of recommendation from your teacher or supervisor will also be included in the selection process if submitted, although this is not a formal requirement.

A selection process will include online interviews with relevant candidates.
